## 關於麥當勞叔叔之家慈善基金 About RMHC Hong Kong

麥當勞叔叔之家慈善基金於1996年展開亞洲區首項 麥當勞叔叔之家服務,為患重病的兒童及其家人提供 一個舒適的「臨時家園」,以一應俱全的住宿設施及相 關服務,幫助有需要家庭互相維繫,彼此關懷。服務 設施鄰近醫院,讓病者家人更能專心照料患病孩子, 一家人同心對抗病魔。

麥當勞叔叔之家備有家庭客房(包括隔離套房)、公用厨房、圖書館、學習室、遊戲區、公共飯廳和有機花園等設施。家舍不僅是臨時的住所,更是給予關懷、支援、互助的「家以外之家」。二十七年來,家舍已為超過8,000名患病兒童及其家人提供超過18萬個晚上住宿。麥當勞叔叔之家慈善基金的第二所家舍將於2023年啟用,鄰近香港兒童醫院,樓高16層,將為更多患重病的孩子及其家人提供「家以外的家」,讓他們得到適切的支援,能夠面對孩子抗病的艱難歷程。

麥當勞叔叔之家慈善基金是政府註冊非牟利機構,根據《稅務條例》第88條獲豁免繳稅,由獨立董事會監管營運,所有服務經費都是靠籌募工作及各界捐助而來。

如欲了解更多關於我們的服務,可瀏覽網頁: www.rmhc.org.hk,或致電2947 8778。 RMHC Hong Kong (Ronald McDonald House Charities® Hong Kong) started the first RMH (Ronald McDonald House®) in Asia in 1996 to provide a "home-away-from-home" for seriously sick children and their families, enabling them to stay close together and receive care and resources they need while the sick child battles a life-threatening disease.

The RMH Hong Kong (Ronald McDonald House ® Hong Kong) Program (Ronald McDonald House ®) facilities include family suits (including an isolation suite), a communal kitchen, library, study room, play area, communal dining area and organic garden. The program not only offers families with seriously sick children a room to stay near the hospital, but also provides comfort, support and resources they need. Since its establishment, more than 180,000 nights have been provided for 7,000 sick children and families. In 2023, a second Ronald McDonald House with 16 floors will commence service. With its proximity to The Hong Kong Children's Hospital, many more families will get the support they need during the critical time when their child undergoes life-saving treatments.

RMHC Hong Kong is an NGO registered under Section 88 of the Hong Kong Inland Revenue Ordinance and governed by an independent Board of Directors.


